




## CAMPANULA collina

Sage-leaved Bellflower

### Plant Description

<b>Article Type</b>	GOLD NUGGET SEED ®
<b>Life Cycle</b>	Perennial
<b>Family</b>	Campanulaceae
<b>Origin</b>	Caucasus, Armenia, North Turkey: mountain meadows, screes.
<b>Special Features</b>	Bellflowers on upright 20-30cm stems, dark blue to blue violett. Petals with hairy-edged lobes, curl well back. Not dry resistant. Very healthy, best for borders.
<b>Historical</b>	Cultivated since 1806.
<b>Basic Colour</b>	(violet)
<b>Flower Colour</b>	violet
<b>Natural Flowering Period</b>	May - July
<b>Winter Hardiness Zones</b>	Z5 - Z9
<b>Foliage</b>	basal leaves heary, ovate-cordate to oblong or lanceolate, crenate, green
<b>Growth Habit</b>	stoloniferous / erect / mat-forming / vigorous
<b>Height with Flowers</b>	20 cm
<b>Spacing between Plants</b>	20 cm
<b>Soil Requirements</b>	moist
<b>Location</b>	
<b>Characteristics</b>	groundcover
<b>Usage</b>	for the rock garden / flowering pot plant

### Cultivation

<b>Grams per 1000 seeds</b>	0.2381 Gram
<b>Seeds per Gram</b>	4200 (does not correspond to the number of plants!)



<b>Sowing Rates/Trays</b>	4 per cell
<b>Plug tray recommended size(s)</b>	72 / 128
<b>Sowing Direction</b>	(15) Rapidly germinating, keep seed in constant moisture (not wet) with temperatures of about +20°C [68°F]. Seeds must be covered thinly. Do not cover very small seeds, but tightly press into the earth. Keep in cooler conditions after germination occurs.

## Scheduling

<b>Best Sowing Date</b>	Anytime (northern Hemisphere, Field condition)
<b>Sowing to Germination</b>	3 - 4 weeks
<b>Cutting back at Transplanting</b>	Not Necessary.

## Growing On

<b>Container Size(s)</b>	1-2 plugs per 11/12 cm (4 1/2")
<b>Fertilizer</b>	Medium (150-200 ppm)
