Plant Description

Life Cycle	Biennial
Family	Caryophyllaceae
Origin	Selection. Species is native to Europe, Asia Minor to Turkestan, Himalayas: open woodlands, roadsides.
Special Features	Mostly biennial, might be perennial after an early pruning. Variable white with red eye selection of the well known Rose Campion. Decorative white and silvery foliage. For natural and cottage gardens. Sows at a matching location itself. Easy to grow!

Flower Colour	white with red eye
Natural Flowering Period	July - August
Winter Hardiness Zones	Z4 - Z8
Foliage	oblong-ovate, lower leaves petioled, upper sessile, white felt-like
Growth Habit	erect / richly branched / evergreen

Cultivation

Grams per 1000 seeds	0.52632 Gram
Seeds per Gram	1900 (does not correspond to the number of plants!)



Gram to get 1000 plants	1 Gram (if sown directly into pots etc. you will need a larger quantity)
Sowing Rates/Trays	3 per cell
Plug tray recommended size(s)	128
Sowing Direction	(15) Rapidly germinating, keep seed in constant moisture (not wet) with temperatures of about +20°C [68°F]. Seeds must be covered thinly. Do not cover very small seeds, but tightly press into the earth. Keep in cooler conditions after germination occurs.

Scheduling

Best Sowing Date	Anytime (northern Hemisphere, Field condition)
Sowing Time Hint	Mid or late summer is best sowing date for most biennial.
Cutting back at Transplanting	Not Necessary.

Growing On

Container Size(s)	1 plug per 8/9 cm (3 1/2")
Fertilizer	Light (100-150 ppm)
