Family Caryophyllaceae

Origin Selection. Eastern Europe, Eastern Asia to South Russia: open woodland,

roadsides.

Distinction Award of Garden Merit (A.G.M.) from the Royal Horticultural Society.

Special Features Fiery red blossoms. Capitate heads 5-10cm across. Very popular and well

known garden plant with average wet soil. Easy to grow.

Historical The species has been in cultivation since 16th century.

Seeds per Gram 2100 (does not correspond to the number of plants!)

Gram to get 1000 plants 1 Gram (if sown directly into pots etc. you will need a larger quantity)

Sowing Rates/Trays 2 - 3 per cell

Plug tray recommended size(s) 128

Sowing Direction (15) Rapidly germinating, keep seed in constant moisture (not wet) with

temperatures of about +20°C [68°F]. Seeds must be covered thinly. Do not cover very small seeds, but tightly press into the earth. Keep in cooler conditions

after germination occurs.

Scheduling

Cutting back at Transplanting Cut-back once to keep more compact.

Growing On

Container Size(s) 1 plug per 8/9 cm (3 1/2") / 1-2 plugs per 11/12 cm (4 1/2")

Fertilizer Medium (150-200 ppm)
