Family	Plantaginaceae
Origin	Cultivar, species grows in Asia, Europe, America: meadows, roadsides, waste areas.
Special Features	Big Leaf Plantain with conspicuously fringed, reddish leaves. Firming upright flowers and seed pods. Large, vigorous plants. Decorative in the pot, but also groundcover use is conceivable. Moderate self-sowing in suitable locations. Salt tolerant.
Historical	The species is well known in traditional medicine.
