## Plant Description

<b>Life Cycle</b>	Perennial
<b>Family</b>	Lamiaceae
<b>Origin</b>	Selection for horticultural use. Origin Europe, Central Asia to Siberia: nutrient poor grassland.
<b>Historical</b>	Used as a remedy in ancient times. Already mentioned by the physician Hippocrates (4th century b.c.).
<b>Basic Colour</b>	(pink / salmon)
<b>Flower Colour</b>	pink
<b>Natural Flowering Period</b>	July - October
<b>Winter Hardiness Zones</b>	Z4 - Z8
<b>Foliage</b>	simple, ovate, slightly hirsute, deep green
<b>Growth Habit</b>	cushion-forming / clumping / vigorous
<b>Height with Flowers</b>	40 cm
<b>Spacing between Plants</b>	20 cm
<b>Soil Requirements</b>	dry / sandy / well-drained / warm

**Sowing Direction**

(15) Rapidly germinating, keep seed in constant moisture (not wet) with temperatures of about +20°C [68°F]. Seeds must be covered thinly. Do not cover very small seeds, but tightly press into the earth. Keep in cooler conditions after germination occurs.
