Life Cycle	Perennial
Family	Asphodelaceae
Origin	South Africa up to Mozambique: costal areas.
Special Features	Attractive succulent leaf with characteristics similar to ALOE vera. Blossoms with an unusual combination of yellow and orange. Easy to grow. Long blooming perennial. Deer resistant. Drought tolerant/ for xeriscaping/ waterwise design.
Historical	Traditonal medicinal plant. Named after Bulbus (lat. bulb) , but misleading, because B. frutescens has no bulb.

500 (does not correspond to the number of plants!)

Gram to get 1000 plants

5 Gram (if sown directly into pots etc. you will need a larger quantity)

Sowing Direction

(15) Rapidly germinating, keep seed in constant moisture (not wet) with temperatures of about +20°C [68°F]. Seeds must be covered thinly. Do not cover very small seeds, but tightly press into the earth. Keep in cooler conditions after germination occurs.
