Family	Lamiaceae
Origin	Central-, South-Europe to Caucasus: dry grassland, woodland margins.
Special Features	Similar to Ajuga reptans, but without above-ground runners and stem is densely hairy on all sides. Attractive for butterflies and other pollinators. Deer and rabbit resistant. Suitable for natural landscaping. Use for low maintenance plantings.

Sowing Direction	(9) These seeds germinate rapidly depending on species and origin. If germination does not occur after 3–4 weeks a cooling period of 2–4 weeks is recommended.
