Life Cycle	Perennial
Family	Campanulaceae
Origin	China, Sichuan, Yunnan: forest clearings and woodland edges.
Special Features	Large flowering. Flowers slit almost all calix. Fine circular drawing around the anthers. Blue violet, in exceptional cases, white. The height might be regulated with the climbing aid.

Flower Colour	blue-violet, rarely white
Natural Flowering Period	July - September

Sowing Direction

(16) See 15 with the exception of germination being slower and more irregular. This poses no problems.

(15) Rapidly germinating, keep seed in constant moisture (not wet) with temperatures of about +20°C [68°F]. Seeds must be covered thinly. Do not cover very small seeds, but tightly press into the earth. Keep in cooler conditions after germination occurs.
