Grams per 1000 seeds	0.51282 Gram

Sowing Rates/Trays	6 per cell
Plug tray recommended size(s)	72 / 128
Sowing Direction	(16) See 15 with the exception of germination being slower and more irregular. This poses no problems. (15) Rapidly germinating, keep seed in constant moisture (not wet) with temperatures of about +20 °C [68 °F]. Seeds must be covered thinly. Do not cover very small seeds, but tightly press into the earth. Keep in cooler conditions after germination occurs.

Scheduling

Best Sowing Date	late autumn - early spring (northern Hemisphere, Field condition)
Sowing to Germination	6 - 10 weeks
Germination to Transplant	4 - 6 weeks
Transplanting to Potting	6 - 8 weeks

Container Size(s)	1 plug per 8/9 cm (3 1/2") / 1-2 plugs per 11/12 cm (4 1/2") / 2-3 plugs per 15 cm (6")
Fertilizer	Medium (150-200 ppm)
