Distinction	Award of Garden Merit (A.G.M.) from the Royal Horticultural Society.
Special Features	Completely winter hardy. Easy to grow. Heat tolerant. Drought tolerant/ for xeriscaping/ waterwise design. Erosion control. Suitable for natural landscaping. Attractive for butterflies and other pollinators. Deer and rabbit resistant. Decorative solitary and structural plant. Remarkable perennial for modern garden design. Use for low maintenance plantings.

Seeds per Gram	85 (does not correspond to the number of plants!)
Gram to get 1000 plants	80 Gram (if sown directly into pots etc. you will need a larger quantity)
Sowing Direction	(20) To obtain best germination results, seeds need temperatures of +22°C [72°F] or more. Moderate, but constant humidity is very important. Gunnera, however, prefers very moist (not wet) and warm (+24 to +30°C) [75 to 86°F] conditions.
