### Plant Description

<b>Life Cycle</b>	Perennial
<b>Family</b>	Campanulaceae
<b>Origin</b>	China: grassy slopes, rocky river terraces.
<b>Special Features</b>	The Bonnet bellflower is very rare in culture. Vigorous, low growing foliage with clearly above white-light blue, bell-shaped flowers, finely violet veined. Very attractive.
<b>Basic Colour</b>	(blue)
<b>Flower Colour</b>	light blue, violet veins
<b>Natural Flowering Period</b>	June - September
<b>Winter Hardiness Zones</b>	Z3 - Z8
<b>Foliage</b>	Ovate, hirsute, vigorous green.
<b>Growth Habit</b>	deep roots / graceful
<b>Height with Flowers</b>	70 cm
<b>Spacing between Plants</b>	20 cm
<b>Soil Requirements</b>	well-drained / average
<b>Location</b>
