Life Cycle	Perennial
Family	Boraginaceae
Origin	Europe (except North), western Asia: roadsides, wastelands.
Special Features	True gentian-blue selection with excellent characteristics. Dwarf and compact growth with nice habit. Short-lived perennial, but moderate self-sowing in suitable locations. Drought tolerant when established. Heat tolerant. Suitable for natural landscaping. Use for low maintenance plantings. Attractive for butterflies and other pollinators. Easy to grow.

Cultivation

Grams per 1000 seeds	25 Gram

Seeds per Gram	40 (does not correspond to the number of plants!)
Gram to get 1000 plants	75 Gram (if sown directly into pots etc. you will need a larger quantity)
Sowing Direction	(7) These seeds must be covered with a layer seed kernel diameter. Keep daytime temperatures at approximately +20°C [68°F], and keep the moisture constant, for Cyclamen, however, +18°C [64°F] is recommended. The seeds must be kept in the light and moderately warm after germination.

Scheduling

Sowing Time Hint	Sow in early summer for overwinter annual. Otherwise anytime.
Cutting back at Transplanting	Not Necessary.

Fertilizer	Light (100-150 ppm)
