### Plant Description

<b>Life Cycle</b>	Perennial
<b>Family</b>	Scrophulariaceae
<b>Special Features</b>	Cream yellow bellflowers, uniform and compact growth, uniform flowering in the first year without vernalization.
<b>Historical</b>	The name Digitalis is derived from digitus, meaning 'finger' in Latin and refers to the shape of the flowers which, more accurately described, look like thimbles.
<b>Basic Colour</b>	(yellow / gold)
<b>Flower Colour</b>	cream yellow
<b>Natural Flowering Period</b>	June - August
<b>Flowering</b>	First year flowering
<b>Winter Hardiness Zones</b>	Z5 - Z8
<b>Growth Habit</b>	compact
<b>Height with Flowers</b>	40 cm
<b>Soil Requirements</b>	dry / well-drained / average

<b>Characteristics</b>	toxic plant

#### **Sowing Direction**

(15) Rapidly germinating, keep seed in constant moisture (not wet) with temperatures of about +20°C [68°F]. Seeds must be covered thinly. Do not cover very small seeds, but tightly press into the earth. Keep in cooler conditions after germination occurs.

No vernalization required for flowering in the first year.
