Plant Description

Life Cycle	Biennial
Family	Campanulaceae
Origin	Western Europe to Russia: sandy dry grassland, heaths.
Special Features	Floriferous, dense cushion forming. Preferably slightly acidic, sandy soils. But also easy to cultivate as a pot plant in standard substrate. Evergreen in the winter. Long flowering period.
Historical	Introduced by JELITTO PERENNIAL SEEDS in 2016.

Flowering	Second year flowering

Sowing Direction

(16) See 15 with the exception of germination being slower and more irregular. This poses no problems.

(15) Rapidly germinating, keep seed in constant moisture (not wet) with temperatures of about +20°C [68°F]. Seeds must be covered thinly. Do not cover very small seeds, but tightly press into the earth. Keep in cooler conditions after germination occurs.

Winter annual plant. Best sowing in early summer.
