### Plant Description

<b>Life Cycle</b>	Perennial
<b>Family</b>	Saxifragaceae
<b>Origin</b>	Manchuria, Northern Korea, Northern China: woodlands, along streams.
<b>Special Features</b>	ASTILBOIDES tabularis is an imposing ornamental foliage plant. With uniform moisture, the leaves of the panel sheet form an excellent background for smaller floriferous perennials in the foreground. Forms an underground rhizome, but not running.
<b>Historical</b>	First description in 1887, excellent results at plant evaluation 1986, but still unfortunately too rare in gardens.
<b>Basic Colour</b>	(white / cream)
<b>Flower Colour</b>	white
<b>Natural Flowering Period</b>	May - July
<b>Winter Hardiness Zones</b>	Z4 - Z8
<b>Foliage</b>	simple, orbicular, hastate, large, light green, ornamental
<b>Growth Habit</b>	rhizomatous / tall / bushy
<b>Height with Flowers</b>	100 cm
<b>Spacing between Plants</b>	100 cm
<b>Soil Requirements</b>	moist / along streamsides / cool
<b>Location</b>	☀️ 🌿 🌞 🌱 🌻
<b>Characteristics</b>	ornamental foliage plant / decorative fruit / groundcover
<b>Usage</b>	suitable for cutting / water or marshplant

### Cultivation



<b>Grams per 1000 seeds</b>	0.08333 Gram
<b>Seeds per Gram</b>	12000 (does not correspond to the number of plants!)
<b>Gram to get 1000 plants</b>	0.25 Gram (if sown directly into pots etc. you will need a larger quantity)
<b>Sowing Direction</b>	(15) Rapidly germinating, keep seed in constant moisture (not wet) with temperatures of about +20°C [68°F]. Seeds must be covered thinly. Do not cover very small seeds, but tightly press into the earth. Keep in cooler conditions after germination occurs.
