Cultivation

Grams per 1000 seeds	2.63158 Gram
Seeds per Gram	380 (does not correspond to the number of plants!)
Gram to get 1000 plants	10 Gram (if sown directly into pots etc. you will need a larger quantity)
Sowing Direction	(19) To stop the germination inhibition give seeds a warm compost (about +22°C) [about 72°F] with constant humidity for at least 6 weeks. Then keep cold (-4 to +4°C) [25 to 39°F] for 6–8 weeks. Usually, the germination starts at +4°C [39°F]. Raise temperatures gradually up to +10°C [50°F] until germination is completed. If the warm or cold period was not long enough the seeds will not germinate until the following year. They will then need another warm period (summer) and a cold period (winter). Well-known examples: Cimicifuga and Helleborus.
