Life Cycle	Perennial
Family	Primulaceae
Origin	Garden origin
Special Features	Early spring flowering. Full sun in cool summer climates to semi-shade elsewhere.
Historical	The original crosses between <i>Primula juliae</i> and <i>P. vulgaris</i> originated at Pruhonice, the Castle of Count Ernst Silva Tarouca, near Prague, Czech Republic, in 1918. Introduced by JELITTO PERENNIAL SEED.

Flower Colour	mixture of red, blue, yellow, white, and pink shades
Natural Flowering Period	March - April
Winter Hardiness Zones	Z5 - Z8
Foliage	shiny, sometimes appearing reddish-brown in early spring

Cultivation

Grams per 1000 seeds	0.8 Gram

Seeds per Gram	1250 (does not correspond to the number of plants!)
Gram to get 1000 plants	2 Gram (if sown directly into pots etc. you will need a larger quantity)
Sowing Rates/Trays	3 per cell
Plug tray recommended size(s)	72 / 128
Sowing Direction	(16) See 15 with the exception of germination being slower and more irregular. This poses no problems. (15) Rapidly germinating, keep seed in constant moisture (not wet) with temperatures of about +20°C [68°F]. Seeds must be covered thinly. Do not cover very small seeds, but tightly press into the earth. Keep in cooler conditions after germination occurs.

Scheduling

Best Sowing Date	Anytime (northern Hemisphere, Field condition)
Sowing Time Hint	Anytime as long as temperatures are not too hot
Sowing to Germination	2 - 3 weeks
Germination to Transplant	4 - 8 weeks
Transplanting to Potting	6 - 10 weeks

Container Size(s)	1 plug per 8/9 cm (3 1/2")
Fertilizer	Medium (150-200 ppm)
