Life Cycle	Perennial
Family	Primulaceae
Origin	Cultivar
Special Features	Winter hardy, early flowering. Very vigorous, best suited for pot production. Compact, decorative foliage. Flower and foliage provide an impressive contrast. Full sun in cool areas is accepted with sufficient irrigation.
Historical	The Latin primus means first, indicating this important genus as being one of the first to flower in spring.

Sowing Direction	(16) See 15 with the exception of germination being slower and more irregular. This poses no problems. (15) Rapidly germinating, keep seed in constant moisture (not wet) with temperatures of about +20 °C [68 °F]. Seeds must be covered thinly. Do not cover very small seeds, but tightly press into the earth. Keep in cooler conditions after germination occurs.
