Origin	Nearly entire Europe, East Asia, Japan, New Zealand, North America: open woodlands and mixed forests.
Special Features	Elegant and resistant sedge for half to full shade. Without runners. Forms dense clumps after a while. Good ground cover under trees. Tolerates changing moisture.
