Plant Description

Life Cycle	Perennial
Family	Rutaceae
Origin	Cultivar. Southern and eastern Europe, southern Central Europe, eastern Mediterranean: shrub heaths and rocky areas.
Special Features	RUTA graveolens f. Variegata has yellow to yellow-white young shoots. The older leaves have a green-white variegation. The white portion in the leaves decreases in autumn and appears again in the spring shoots. The Variegata form has the same requirements as the RUTA graveolens species and is cultivated in the same way.

Grams per 1000 seeds	2.22222 Gram
Seeds per Gram	450 (does not correspond to the number of plants!)



Gram to get 1000 plants	10 Gram (if sown directly into pots etc. you will need a larger quantity)
Plug tray recommended size(s)	72 / 128
Sowing Direction	(16) See 15 with the exception of germination being slower and more irregular. This poses no problems. (15) Rapidly germinating, keep seed in constant moisture (not wet) with temperatures of about +20°C [68°F]. Seeds must be covered thinly. Do not cover very small seeds, but tightly press into the earth. Keep in cooler conditions after germination occurs.

Container Size(s)	1 plug per 8/9 cm (3 1/2") / 1-2 plugs per 11/12 cm (4 1/2")
Fertilizer	Medium (150-200 ppm)
