Life Cycle	Perennial
Family	Dipsacaceae
Origin	Europe, Alps, Apennins: rocky areas, thickets, mountain meadows.
Special Features	Delicate yellow, scabious-like, hemispherical flowerheads. Transparent, light-looking habit. Attractive for butterflies and other pollinators. Suitable for natural horticulture. Self-sowing at suitable landscaping. Use for low maintenance plantings..

Cultivation

Grams per 1000 seeds	20.83333 Gram

Sowing Direction

(8) These perennial seeds germinate very irregularly over a long period. Lower temperatures of less than +5°C [41°F] are very effective. Seed trays should not be discarded prematurely. Constant moisture must be maintained. Do not leave in direct sunlight. For Alstroemeria we recommend to keep sowing for 3 weeks at approximately +30°C [86°F], then 3 weeks at +5°C [41°F], then at +21°C [70°F].

Scheduling

Sowing Time Hint

All year long. Keep seed pots at least one cold season.

1-2 plugs per 11/12 cm (4 1/2")
