Life Cycle	Perennial
Family	Caryophyllaceae
Origin	The origin of DIANTHUS plumarius are the calcareous mountains of Central Europe from Italy to Poland. The easy hybridisation of this species led to numerous varieties.
Distinction	Fleuroselect Award Winner.
Special Features	DIANTHUS plumarius nanus 'Sweetness' is a mix of simple, fragrant flowers. The colors vary from light pink, pink to dark red shades. The growth is compact, this is perfect not only for the rock garden, but also for pots, troughs and flower boxes. Dianthus plumarius is well known for its aromatic fragrant. The variety nanus 'Sweetness' improves it considerably.

Grams per 1000 seeds	1.21951 Gram
Seeds per Gram	820 (does not correspond to the number of plants!)
Gram to get 1000 plants	3 Gram (if sown directly into pots etc. you will need a larger quantity)
Plug tray recommended size(s)	128
Sowing Direction	(15) Rapidly germinating, keep seed in constant moisture (not wet) with temperatures of about +20°C [68°F]. Seeds must be covered thinly. Do not cover very small seeds, but tightly press into the earth. Keep in cooler conditions after germination occurs.
