Life Cycle	Perennial
Family	Hyacinthaceae
Origin	Western North America: mountain meadows, prairie, banks.
Distinction	Award of Garden Merit (A.G.M.) from the Royal Horticultural Society.
Special Features	Mostly creamy-white star-shaped flower racemes. Tolerates more moisture in the substrate than most other bulbous plants. Suitable for natural landscaping. Deer resistant.
Historical	Named after the botanist and breeder Max Leichtlin (1831-1910), Baden-Baden (Germany).

Flower Colour	mostly creamy white
Natural Flowering Period	May - July
Winter Hardiness Zones	Z3 - Z7
Foliage	Entire, linear, pointed, green.

Seeds per Gram	130 (does not correspond to the number of plants!)
Gram to get 1000 plants	15 Gram (if sown directly into pots etc. you will need a larger quantity)
Sowing Direction	(8) These perennial seeds germinate very irregularly over a long period. Lower temperatures of less than +5°C [41°F] are very effective. Seed trays should not be discarded prematurely. Constant moisture must be maintained. Do not leave in direct sunlight. For Alstroemeria we recommend to keep sowing for 3 weeks at approximately +30°C [86°F], then 3 weeks at +5°C [41°F], then at +21°C [70°F].
