Life Cycle	Perennial
Family	Campanulaceae
Origin	Europe, North Africa, Siberia; open woodland, forrest margins.
Special Features	Medium-high bellflower for light shade and semi-shade. Full sun is accepted with sufficient moisture. Valuable seedling for native-plant gardens. Self seeding at suitable locations. Preferrres average, calcareous soils with shrubs and grasses.

Sowing Direction

(16) See 15 with the exception of germination being slower and more irregular. This poses no problems.

(15) Rapidly germinating, keep seed in constant moisture (not wet) with temperatures of about +20°C [68°F]. Seeds must be covered thinly. Do not cover very small seeds, but tightly press into the earth. Keep in cooler conditions after germination occurs.

Cutting back at Transplanting

Cut-back once to keep more compact.
