Plant Description

Life Cycle	Perennial
Family	Asteraceae
Origin	Cultivar. Species is native to the Balkan Peninsula. Now found in Australia, Europe, China, Japan, North Africa and the North America: roadsides, waste areas, fields.
Special Features	CHRYSANTHEMUM parthenium 'Golden Moss' gets attention, because of the unusual structure of the foliage. The color of the leaves is bright and friendly, supported by the well-known and popular flowers of feverfew.
Historical	Synonyms to CHRYSANTHEMUM parthenium are TANACETUM parthenium, LEUCANTHEMUM parthenium, PYRETHRUM parthenium and MATRICARIA parthenium.

Cultivation

Grams per 1000 seeds	0.08333 Gram
Seeds per Gram	12000 (does not correspond to the number of plants!)
Gram to get 1000 plants	0.25 Gram (if sown directly into pots etc. you will need a larger quantity)
Sowing Rates/Trays	3 - 4 per cell
Plug tray recommended size(s)	72
Sowing Direction	(16) See 15 with the exception of germination being slower and more irregular. This poses no problems. (15) Rapidly germinating, keep seed in constant moisture (not wet) with temperatures of about +20°C [68°F]. Seeds must be covered thinly. Do not cover very small seeds, but tightly press into the earth. Keep in cooler conditions after germination occurs.
