Special Features	Pleated blue-green leaves in contrast to orange-red flowers (poppy-like). Decorative long seed pods up to 25 cm long. Drought resistant and easy-to-grow.

Grams per 1000 seeds	1.47059 Gram
Seeds per Gram	680 (does not correspond to the number of plants!)
Gram to get 1000 plants	4 Gram (if sown directly into pots etc. you will need a larger quantity)

Plug tray recommended size(s)	72 / 128



Sowing Direction

(9) These seeds germinate rapidly depending on species and origin. If germination does not occur after 3–4 weeks a cooling period of 2–4 weeks is recommended.

Scheduling

Best Sowing Date	late autumn - early spring (northern Hemisphere, Field condition)
Sowing to Germination	4 - 8 weeks
Germination to Transplant	4 - 6 weeks
Transplanting to Potting	6 - 8 weeks

Container Size(s)	1-2 plugs per 11/12 cm (4 1/2")
Fertilizer	Light (100-150 ppm)
