Life Cycle	Perennial
Family	Scrophulariaceae
Origin	North America, Canada, USA, Rocky Mountains: rocky slopes, prairie.
Special Features	Light yellow, an unusual Penstemon color. Best in full sun and rather dry soil.
Basic Colour	(yellow / gold)
Flower Colour	light yellow
Natural Flowering Period	May - July
Winter Hardiness Zones	Z3 - Z8
Foliage	lanceolate, green
Height with Flowers	30 cm
Spacing between Plants	25 cm

Cultivation

Grams per 1000 seeds	0.08333 Gram
Seeds per Gram	12000 (does not correspond to the number of plants!)
Gram to get 1000 plants	3 Gram (if sown directly into pots etc. you will need a larger quantity)



Sowing Direction

(8) These perennial seeds germinate very irregularly over a long period. Lower temperatures of less than +5°C [41°F] are very effective. Seed trays should not be discarded prematurely. Constant moisture must be maintained. Do not leave in direct sunlight. For Alstroemeria we recommend to keep sowing for 3 weeks at approximately +30°C [86°F], then 3 weeks at +5°C [41°F], then at +21°C [70°F].

1 plug per 8/9 cm (3 1/2") / 1-2 plugs per 11/12 cm (4 1/2")

Fertilizer

Medium (150-200 ppm)
