Origin	Cultivar. Pyrenees; also infrequently in West Central and South Europe.
Special Features	Very popular small flowering variety.

Cultivation

Grams per 1000 seeds	0.625 Gram
Seeds per Gram	1600 (does not correspond to the number of plants!)
Gram to get 1000 plants	3 Gram (if sown directly into pots etc. you will need a larger quantity)
Sowing Direction	(15) Rapidly germinating, keep seed in constant moisture (not wet) with temperatures of about +20 °C [68 °F]. Seeds must be covered thinly. Do not cover very small seeds, but tightly press into the earth. Keep in cooler conditions after germination occurs.
